PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

I will not force my child to participate in soccer.

I will teach my child the importance of being gracious in both victory and in defeat.

I will teach my child that it is good to win but it is more important that they always play to the best of their ability and that they recognize the importance of teamwork.

I will encourage my child to play by the rules of the game and to resolve on field conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.

I will praise my child for trying hard and competing fairly.

I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other players on their team, the coaches or the officials.

I will show appreciation and acknowledge good play from both teams.

I will show respect for the opposition and their supporters.

I will show respect for all match day officials and will not question their calls, bias or judgment in public.

I will show respect for the volunteer coaches and officials from all teams that give their time to the game.

I understand that in order for my child to have equal and/or fair participation in games they must attend the practices. In the event that my child cannot attend a game/practice I will inform the manager at the earliest opportunity.

I will remember the players are not professional soccer players and should not be judged as such.

At games and at practice I will remember that they have a coach and I will not try to coach from the sidelines or stands unless I am asked to by an official from the team.

I will wait 24 hours from any game or practice before contacting any club official, including the coach if I have any concerns I would like to discuss with them.

When using social media, (Facebook, Twitter etc), I will respect the rights and confidentiality of others; not impersonate or falsely represent another person, not bully, intimidate, abuse, harass or threaten others (teammates, opponents, officials etc). I will not post content that is hateful, threatening, or incites violence against others, or post content that harms the reputation and good standing of

SSC or those within its community.



Respect for Others/Harassment

- SFC is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect.
- It does not allow discriminatory practices.
- Disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist remarks or actions are not appropriate behaviour. Respect for team mates, coaches, and officials, opposing team members, staff and their families all falls within the requirements for respectful behaviour.
- Parents must abide by the CSA harassment policy. Harassment is improper behaviour related to one or more prohibited grounds that are offensive and which the person knew, or ought to reasonably have known would be inappropriate or unwelcome. The behaviour can be verbal or physical and can occur on a one-time, repeated, or continuous basis.
- A person does not have to intend to harass for the behaviour to be harassment. Harassment can take many forms but generally involves conduct, comment or display that is insulting, intimidating, humiliating, hurtful, demeaning, belittling malicious, degrading or/can otherwise cause offence, discomfort, or personal humiliation or embarrassment to a person or a group of persons.
